## FIRST READING: Hebrews 9:24-end

For Christ did not enter a sanctuary made by human  
hands, a mere copy of the true one, but he entered  
into heaven itself, now to appear in the presence of  
God on our behalf. Nor was it to offer himself again  
and again, as the high priest enters the Holy Place  
year after year with blood that is not his own; for  
then he would have had to suffer again and again  
since the foundation of the world. But as it is, he has  
appeared once for all at the end of the age to  
remove sin by the sacrifice of himself. And just as it  
is appointed for mortals to die once, and after that  
the judgement, so Christ, having been offered once  
to bear the sins of many, will appear a second time,  
not to deal with sin, but to save those who are  
eagerly waiting for him.

## Remembrance Poem - In Flanders Fields 1915

In Flanders fields the poppies blow  
Between the crosses, row on row,  
That mark our place; and in the sky  
The larks, still bravely singing, fly  
Scarce heard amid the guns below.

We are the Dead. Short days ago
